

ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 1985

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING WRITE-IN VOTES IN
LOCAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, C. R. S. 31-10-306, as amended, authorizes municipalities to require an affidavit of intent for write-in candidates; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to adopt such provisions for the Town of Jamestown;

AND WHEREAS, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Jamestown, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. No write-in vote for any Town office shall be counted unless the person whose name appears on the write-in vote has filed an affidavit of intent with the Town Clerk prior to five (5) days before the day of the election indicating that such person desires the office and is qualified to assume the duties of that office if elected.
