

ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 2003

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF TOWN FUNDS  
FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A CONSERVATION EASEMENT  
FOR THE BLUE JAY MINE PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Jamestown and the County of Boulder have entered into a contract for the purchase of a conservation easement for the Boulder County Open Space property known as the Blue Jay Mine, and

**WHEREAS**, the Purchase and Sale Contract provides that the Town shall pay the County a total of \$5000.00 for the Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board by this ordinance desires to identify the source of funding for such purchase and otherwise comply with the Colorado Revised Statutes regarding the acquisition of the Property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:**

**Section 1.** Moneys from the Town Parks Fund shall be used to pay the purchase price of the easement, which is described in the Purchase Agreement.

**Section 2.** Payment for the Easement shall be made in cash, certified funds Town check, subject to the Purchase and Sale Contract and to any necessary budgetary transfers or supplementary budgets and appropriations in accordance with State law.

**Section 3.** Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to nor should be construed to create any multiple-fiscal year direct or indirect Town debt or fiscal obligation whatsoever.

**Section 4.** If any portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part be declared invalid.

**Section 5.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.
