

RESOLUTION # 17, SERIES 2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR  
A HISTORIC STRUCTURE ASSESSMENT OF THE TOWN HALL

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by Section 31-15-401, C.R.S., which provides that the Town Board shall have the power to provide for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the community; and,

WHEREAS, in special election conducted in 2003 the electorate supported a temporary mill levy to repair and restore the Town Hall, and,


WHEREAS, the Town has received a \$10,000 grant from the State Historical Fund for this purpose, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose: The purpose of this resolution to authorize the Mayor to negotiate for services associated with the historic structure assessment of the Jamestown Town Hall. Such services shall not exceed \$10,290 or the limits specified in the Town's contract 2005-HA-039 with the State Historical Fund as revised.

Section 2. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective immediately, upon approval by the Board and signature by the Mayor.
