A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AMENDMENT TO THE U.S. CONSTITUTION CONCERNING THE CORRUPTING EFFECTS OF UNDUE CORPORATE INFLUENCE IN AMERICA

WHEREAS, The Town Board of Jamestown has received a petition signed by 48 residents supporting the following resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

The People of Jamestown, Colorado call for reclaiming democracy from the corrupting effects of undue corporate influence by amending the United States Constitution to establish that:

- 1. Only human beings, not corporations, are entitled to constitutional rights, and
- 2. Money is not speech, and therefore regulating political contributions and spending is not equivalent to limiting political speech.
