

Ordinance 5, Series 2012

REPEAL OF ORDINANCE CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENT OF THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, the Town of Jamestown adopted Ordinance 7 Series 1988 which provided for the process and limitations for mayoral reimbursement and;

WHEREAS, reimbursement of expenses for elected officials, employees and volunteers is addressed in Town expense policies; and

WHEREAS: the Board of Trustees of Jamestown wishes to repeal the previous ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:


Section 1. Repeal: Upon the effective date of this ordinance, Ordinance 7, Series 1988, is hereby repealed in its entirety. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

Section 3. Severability: If any portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid for any reason, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part be declared invalid.
