

RESOLUTION 3-3, SERIES 2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF JAMERSTOWN TO ENTER INTO A ROAD
MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH BOULDER COUNTY

WHEREAS, §43-2-144 of the Colorado Revised Statutes authorizes the County and the Town to enter into intergovernmental agreements for maintenance of roads, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Jamestown and County of Boulder entered into a road maintenance agreement dated March 9, 1993, and

WHEREAS the Town Board of Trustees wishes to adopt standards for roads and bridges based on County codes and standards as revised, and


WHEREAS, The Town Board of Trustees and the County intend to create a more desirable division of maintenance responsibilities as set forth in a revised agreement that includes routine maintenance for traffic control devices and specified roadways, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN,
