James & Little James Creeks Design Meeting

- Boulder County and the Lefthand Watershed Oversight Group (LWOG) are:
 - Developing stream restoration designs for James and Little James Creeks.
 - Assessing the Emergency Watershed Protection work through town.
- Community meeting held June 1 draft 30% designs
- Comment period ended June 10
- Final 30% designs completed end of June
- Funding from Boulder County and Natural Resources Conservation Service Emergency Watershed Protection Program
- Construction is planned to begin in concert with necessary road construction, currently expected to begin late fall- early winter of 2016 (may be phased due to task and season)

Drainage & Stormwater Management Master Plan

- Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Round 3
- \$100,000 grant for:
 - Drainage study to find solutions to drainage issues
 - Identification of stormwater management opportunities
 - 30% design for solutions
- Expect "go ahead" from State in June/July
 - Scoping and request for proposals
 - Project start mid summer

2 properties are included in the HMGP Elevation Program – 40 & 99 Main

Elevations Engineering contract scheduled to be awarded 6/13/16

Lower Main Street Bridge – Phase 1 Engineering/Design

- The selected engineers will provide option(s) to the Town based on FEMA edibility requirements, codes and standards, and the latest hydrology analysis
- The selected option will be designed to 100%
- FEMA will review the design for Benefit Cost Analysis and environmental impact to determine if additional funding will be provided for the construction
- Design is scheduled to be complete by the end of the year

Town Square Restoration – Phase 1 (FEMA/CDBG-DR)


Phase 1

• Where we are starting...



GOAL: to restore the Town Square to its pre-flood elevation – includes debris removal, excavation & creating new contour lines, importation of fill and top soil.

- Colt & Steel are scheduled to be complete by July 8th.
- Phase 2 will begin after Phase 1 is signed off.






Town Square Restoration – Phase 2 (GOCO)

Phase 2

• Where we are headed....

GOAL: To reconstruct Andersen Hill and Bridge, the Town swapped land with the Church. The swap included some of Town Square property. Even with this, the Church gave more than they got. This adjustment resulted in moving the western border of the Town Square 25' to the east.






Town Square Restoration – Phase 2

- a) smaller size & relocation of ramada to

- b) fewer trees
- c) steeper sides in order to have larger flat area
- d) added terrace
- e) Bike rack & fountain locations







Gillespie Gulch Construction Update






Irrigation Ditch Reconstruction Update

• Once the new LED street lights are operational, customers pay a monthly rate. For pricing, refer to Schedule SL, Option A LED Service Option Charge.


• Xcel Energy will meet with you to discuss the conversion schedule and specific areas that you want (or do not wish) to convert.

Residential LED Lighting - 9th Street, Hudson, Wis.






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- Rectangle is 24' Wide Road Set 11' (10' Shoulder and 1' Setback) from Fixture
