



RESOLUTION #2, SERIES 2004

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A BALLOT ISSUE TO BE PLACED BEFORE VOTERS FOR ELIMINATION OF TERM LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by Section 31-15-401, C.R.S., which provides that the Town Board shall have the power to provide for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to encourage those citizens that are willing to serve the Town Board longer than permitted by State law and recognizes that within a small community it is often difficult to obtain a full Board of unpaid volunteers; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1. Purpose</u>: The purpose of this resolution is to refer a ballot questions to the voters of Jamestown during the April 2004 election.

<u>Section 2. Ballot Question to improve Safety Services:</u> The Board is resolved to adopt a ballot question that would repeal local term limits in accordance with Colorado State law, to be decided by the voters of the Town.

<u>Section 3. Effective Date:</u> This resolution shall become effective immediately, upon approval by the Board and signature by the Mayor.
