A RESOLUTION OF INTENT OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY AND INITIATING ANNEXATION PROCEEDINGS FOR SUCH PROPERTY TO BE KNOWN AS THE GOLDEN AGE ROAD ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, THE PROPERTY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IS POTENTIALLY ADJACENT TO THE TOWN UNDER THE ANNEXATION LAWS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, AND;

WHEREAS, 100 PERCENT OF THE OWNERS OF SAID PROPERTY(S) HAVE PETITIONED THE TOWN FOR ANNEXATION, AND;

WHEREAS, THE TOWN BOARD OF JAMESTOWN DESIRES TO INITIATE ANNEXATION PROCEEDINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW, AND;

THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the Town Board of Jamestown intends to annex the following described property to be known as the Golden Age Road Annexation situate in the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, to wit.

Properties as described and submitted per Annexation Map and Legal description of properties.

Section 2. The Town Board hereby finds the petition for annexation to be in substantial compliance with Section 31-12-107(1) CRS and initiates annexation proceedings for the above described property subject to the following requirements:

- 1. The petitioners shall submit a surveyors map of the property(s) to be annexed.
- 2. The petitioners shall submit legal description(s) of the property to be annexed. (Exhibits)
- 3. The petitioners shall cause to complete the Petition for Annexation including total acres, affidavit of circulator and notarization of same.
- 4. The petitioners sign a cost agreement with the Town.
- 5. The Mayor shall consult with principals and set a date of public hearing according to law.
- 6. The Mayor shall instruct the Town Clerk to post notice of public hearing in accordance with law.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a cost agreement with the petitioners, determine that requirements one through three above have been completed and set a date for public hearing.
