A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF LETTERS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SENATE BILL 06-090

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-29-103(2)(b), the governing body of each local government must provide peace officers with written notice of the duty to cooperate with state and federal officials with regards to enforcement of state and federal immigration laws; and

WHEREAS, Boulder County Sheriff's Office provides law enforcement services for the Town; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 29-29-103(2)(b), the governing body of each local government must provide written confirmation to the general assembly that it has provided such notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposed notice to Sheriff Pelle in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, the written confirmation to the General Assembly in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B, and the proposed letter to DOLA in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C are approved.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the notices, except that the Mayor is hereby further granted the authority to revise and approve revisions to said notice and written confirmation so long as the essential terms and conditions of the notice and written confirmation are not altered.
