## TOWN OF JAMESTOWN RESOLUTION NO. 19, SERIES 2013

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2014 TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO FOR THE 2013 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Jamestown has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget on December 10, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary for general operating expenses of the Town is \$54,246.68 and

WHEREAS, the 2013 assessed valuation of the Town of Jamestown as certified by the County Assessor is \$2,932,253.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses for the Town of Jamestown during the 2014 budget year, is hereby levied a tax of 18.50 mills upon each dollar of the valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Jamestown, Boulder County, Colorado for the year 2014.

Section 2. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Boulder County, Colorado the mill levies for the Town of Jamestown as hereinabove determined and set.
