A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2016 TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO FOR THE 2016 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Jamestown has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget on December 7, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary for general operating expenses of the Town is \$75,635; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 assessed valuation of the Town of Jamestown as certified by the County Assessor is \$3,001,403.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF JAMESTOWN, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses for the Town of Jamestown during the 2016 budget year is hereby levied a tax of 25.200 upon each dollar of the valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town of Jamestown, Boulder County, Colorado for the year 2016.

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Boulder County, Colorado the mill levies for the Town of Jamestown as hereinabove determined and set.
